## The Value of Your Network

Your KelseyCare Advantage plan is built around care provided by Kelsey-Seybold physicians and locations. For all KelseyCare Advantage plans, receiving services in-network ensures your care is covered and well-coordinated.

- **Low Copays:** You pay low in-network copays for office visits, labs, and imaging when you stay in the network. If you have the Freedom (HMO-POS) plan, you have the flexibility to go out-of-network, but doing so comes with higher costs.
- **A Connected Team:** Your specialists and your Primary Care Provider (PCP) use the same medical record system. This keeps everyone on the same page and saves you from carrying paper records between offices.
- **Coordinated Care:** All our plans are built to manage your health in one place. This allows your team to consult with each other quickly to get you the right treatment.

## Know Where to Go: ER vs. Urgent Care

Choosing the right spot for after-hours care saves you time and money. Unless it is a life-threatening emergency, call our After-Hours Nurse Hotline at 713-442-0000 first.

- **Urgent Care or Virtual Care:** Best for minor cuts, sprains, rashes, or the flu. These options are faster and cost less than an ER visit.
- **Emergency Room:** Call 911 or head to the ER for chest pain, difficulty breathing, sudden weakness, or uncontrolled bleeding.

- **See an APC:** Nurse Practitioners and Physician Assistants work directly with your doctor. They often have earlier openings for common health needs.
- **Choose Any Location:** You aren't limited to just one clinic. You can book at any Kelsey-Seybold location to find the next available opening—including Saturdays and same-day visits.
- **Try Virtual Care:** Connect with a provider from home through Video Visits or E-Visit. It's a convenient way to get a diagnosis without the commute.
